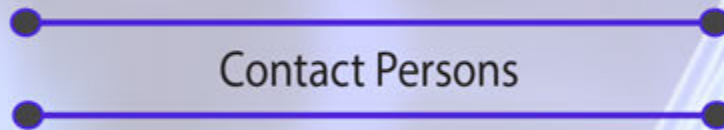
KIIT Technology Business Incubator :
